WHY STUDY AND FOLLOW THE BIBLE?

The Bible itself gives many reasons. Notice especially the last one, which has special significance for government leaders.

1. To connect with God and be saved

2 Timothy 3:15 "you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus."

2. To have faith (trust) in God

Romans 10:17 "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ."

3. To love God as He loves you

Deuteronomy 6:5-6 "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. These words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart."

4. To hear from God

1 Corinthians 2:13 "And we impart this in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit"

5. To grow in maturity

1 Peter 2:2 "Like newborn babes, long for the pure milk of the word, that by it you may grow in respect to salvation."
(See also 1 Corinthians 3:1-2, Hebrews 5:12-14)

6. To be spiritually strong

Matthew 4:4 "But Jesus answered, "It is written, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God." (See also Job 23:12.)

7. To fulfill the mission you are made for

2 Timothy 3:16-17 "All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work." (See also John 8:31)

8. To be wise

Psalms 119:98 "O how I love Your law! It is my meditation all the day. Your commandments make me wiser than my enemies."

9. To make good decisions

Psalms 119:105 "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." (See also Psalm 32:8)

10. To stay strong against temptation

Psalms 119:11 "I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you."

11. To know good from evil

Hebrews 5:14 "But solid food is for the mature, who because of practice have their senses trained to discern good and evil."

12. To recognize truth from error

2 Timothy 2:15 "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth."

13. To have courage

Psalm 56:3-4 "When I am afraid, I will put my trust in You. In God, whose word I praise, in God I have put my trust."

14. To have peace and joy

Psalm 19:8 "The precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart."

15. To be comforted in difficult times

Psalm 119:50 "This is my comfort in my affliction, that Your word has revived me."

16. To help others to know God

1 Peter 3:15 "In your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect."

17. To be blessed

Revelation 1:3 "Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of the prophecy, and heed the things which are written in it."

18. To prosper

Psalm 1:1-3 "How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, nor stand in the path of sinners, nor sit in the seat of scoffers! But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night. He will be like a tree firmly planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in its season and its leaf does not wither; and in whatever he does, he prospers."

19. To be a successful government leader

Deuteronomy 17:18-20 "And when [the king] sits on the throne of his kingdom, he shall write for himself in a book a copy of this law, and it shall be with him, and he shall read in it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the Lord his God by keeping all the words of this law and these statutes, and doing them, that his heart may not be lifted up above his brothers, and that he may not turn aside from the commandment, either to the right hand or to the left, so that he may continue long in his kingdom, he and his children ..."

In this last passage, God commanded Israel's king to make his own copy of the Bible, keep it with him at all times, read from it daily, and follow it closely. If the king did so, he would stay humble, make good decisions, enjoy a long reign, and along with his family be blessed.

In the same way, you will also be blessed if you regularly study and follow the teachings of the Bible, even in Sacramento. Please join us as we meet together for this purpose throughout this year.
