Daniel 5 and Isaiah 45:1

To what do you attribute your safety and peace? Is it encapsulated in anything made by human hands?

While we have metal detectors, body scanners, and pat downs, these devices cannot scan or discover the intent of the heart of man.

Man looks on the outward appearance. Only God can see the heart of man.

But the LORD said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for the LORD seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart. – I Samuel 16:7

Our safety is not dependent on what we feel or see. We are sustained by an Almighty God that is sovereign over the affairs of men. God prophesied through Isaiah that King Cyrus would conquer and free the captives, 150 years before King Cyrus was born!
