**Matthew 22:23-33** *“On that day some Sadducees (who say there is no resurrection) came to Jesus and questioned Him, (24) asking, ‘Teacher, Moses said, “IF A MAN DIES HAVING NO CHILDREN, HIS BROTHER AS NEXT OF KIN SHALL MARRY HIS WIFE, AND RAISE UP CHILDREN FOR HIS BROTHER.” (25) Now there were seven brothers with us; and the first married and died, and having no children left his wife to his brother; (26) so also the second, and the third, down to the seventh. (27) Last of all, the woman died. (28) In the resurrection, therefore, whose wife of the seven will she be? For they all had married her.’ (29) But Jesus answered and said to them, ‘You are mistaken, not understanding the Scriptures nor the power of God. (30) For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven. (31) But regarding the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was spoken to you by God: (32) “I AM THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, AND THE GOD OF ISAAC, AND THE GOD OF JACOB”? He is not the God of the dead but of the living.’ (33) When the crowds heard this, they were astonished at His teaching.”*

Throughout all history mankind has anticipated the afterlife. The concept is woven into the fiber of the heart that there must be a more meaningful existence after death. James Dwight Dana, the Yale professor whose writings are still used as textbooks today, said that he “could not believe that God would create man and then desert him at the grave.”<sup>1</sup> The Egyptian Pyramids are royal tombs with provisions for the afterlife. All men feel that pull toward eternity and the Jews of Christ’s day were no exception. King David had written long ago, “*Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever*” (Ps. 23:6). Daniel states it the clearest, “*And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt*” (12:2).

### I. THE BUREAUCRATIC BELIEFS MT. 22:23

The Sadducees were the elite aristocrats of Israel and had authority over the Temple, the priesthood and they had the majority control of the Sanhedrin (the legislative body of Israel). Their wealth had primarily been obtained from the lucrative money changing and sacrifice sales in the temple courtyard. Obviously they felt severely threatened when Jesus cleansed the Temple of their extortion. They sided with Rome politically for their own advantage and were especially despised by the people. But their defection to the

## What You Believe Directly Effects Your Actions!

Romans bought them permission to have the only police force in Israel in the form of the Temple Guard. Religiously, they were generally more liberal, yet extremely rigid in two areas. Their judgments against the people were more vicious than anyone else and they pridefully taught that only the first five books of Moses were Scripture. Such led them to extremes in Levitical purity while boasting as the preservers of the true faith. They denied the existence of angels or the resurrection so they could treat others any way they pleased without eternal consequence. But suddenly their accountability to God had been engaged by Christ. So with scorn they approach Him with Scripture intended to trap Him.

### II. THE BUREAUCRATIC BLINDNESS MT. 22:24-28

They address Jesus with flattery as “*teacher*” to set Him up for their “impossible” question. They refer to the law found in Deuteronomy 25:5-6 stating that “*if a man dies, having no children, his brother as next of kin shall marry his wife, and raise up an offspring to his brother.*” There are two examples of such in Genesis 38:8-10 and Ruth 4:1-10. The story of Ruth not only depicts the preservation of her husband’s lineage, but also God’s preservation of the lineage of Jesus Christ, the Messiah. The Sadducees then paint a scenario making the teaching of the Pharisees regarding an exact physical continuance in the resurrection seem absurd. “*Now there were seven brothers with us; and the first married and died, and having no children left his wife to his brother; so also the second, and the third, down to the seventh. Last of all, the woman died. In the resurrection, therefore, whose wife*

*of the seven will she be? For they all had married her.*” Legally, how could that many marriage relationships in heaven possibly be reconciled? Or if heaven would not be “heaven” for some in this scenario, then heaven or the resurrection did not exist. This scenario does pose great difficulty for the Muslim who believes that he will be given multiple virgins as wives in heaven but it reveals a blindness to the truth about the resurrection.

### III. THE BRILLIANCE OF THE KING MT. 22:29-33

Jesus shames them with three areas of failure: 1) they “*are mistaken*,” 2) they don’t understand the Scriptures, 3) they don’t understand the power of God. The second is the cause of the other two. They only saw the Scriptures as an authority to disprove, rather than seeking to understand and obey it. Jesus’ deity is again proven as He states that which only God could have known about heaven, “*They neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are like the angels in heaven.*” He answers their question with the familiar Scripture Moses had written, emphasizing the emphatic present tense, “*I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob*” (Exodus 6:3). “*He is not the God of the dead but of the living.*” The Sadducees belief would require that the patriarchs not exist because they are dead. How can God be God of one who does not exist? They are alive!
