Acts 13:20-28 *“And after these things He gave them judges until Samuel the Prophet. 21) And then they asked for a king, and God gave them Saul the son of Kish, a man of the tribe of Benjamin, for forty years. 22) And after He had removed him, He raised up David to be their king, concerning whom He also testified and said, ‘I HAVE FOUND DAVID the son of Jesse, A MAN AFTER MY HEART, who will do all My will.’ 23) From the offspring of this man, according to promise, God has brought to Israel a Savior, Jesus, 24) after John had proclaimed before His coming a baptism of repentance to all the people of Israel. 25) And while John was completing his course, he kept saying, ‘What do you suppose that I am? I am not He. But behold, one is coming after me the sandals of whose feet I am not worthy to untie.’ 26) Brethren, sons of Abraham’s family, and those among you who fear God, to us the word of this salvation is sent out. 27) For those who live in Jerusalem, and their rulers, recognizing neither Him nor the utterances of the prophets which are read every Sabbath, fulfilled these by condemning Him. 28) And though they found no ground for putting Him to death, they asked Pilate the He be executed.” (NASB)*

“JONAH, THE ONLY DISOBEDIENT PROPHET WHEN SENT TO THE GENTILES, SAID IT BEST FROM THE BELLY OF THE GREAT FISH AT THE BOTTOM OF THE OCEAN, WHEN HIS REBELLION HAD BEEN OVERCOME AND HE REALIZED THAT THE FISH, WHICH SHOULD HAVE BEEN HIS DESTRUCTION WAS ACTUALLY HIS SALVATION, HE PROCLAIMED, ‘SALVATION IS OF THE LORD.’” (JONAH 2:9)

Who were the Israelites rejecting when they asked for a king? Which of his servants rescued Saul in the valley of Elah? Was this the first time Paul referred to his namesake in his sermon? Why did the Lord find David “A MAN AFTER MY HEART”? What was the continuous expectation of all Israel? How was John the greatest yet most humble prophet? What are the most important Scriptures to accept and believe?

The Lord has chosen this mission team and they have left Antioch of Syria and proclaimed the Gospel in both the provincial capital and the primary capital of the island of Cyprus. The mission becomes dramatic as they meet with the Proconsul, Sergius Paulus, and this first king sees the truth while Bar-Jesus is blinded. Grateful Saul seizes the leader’s name, Paul, in celebration of the first fruits of his commission (9:15). John Mark rejects Paul’s leadership and deserts the team in Perga, the capital of Pamphylia. Sickness then drove Paul to higher altitude as he forded the dangerous rivers and scaled the heights of the Taurus Mountains full of robbers to land in Pisidian Antioch, the capital where Paul preaches his first recorded sermon. Paul points to the unexpected, as the wisdom of God continually overcomes the wickedness of men, historically, prophetically and practically.
