A^{bout} – Heart for Home

Mt.24:32-44-25:46

B^{est Verse} – Matthew 25:21, 23, “Well done good and faithful servant...”¹ These are the words of the Master your heart most *wants* to hear. The *wise* servant proactively bends every choice in his Master’s direction with expectation of His immanent return.^{5b-24:45-51} That servant has oil in his and her storehouse, *watching* and ready to trim the lamp for the Bridegroom to join Him at the wedding feast when, at last, He arrives.^{6a-25:1-13} Whatever the servant possesses: One, two, or five talents, when the Master returns He finds them *working*—fully vested for multiplied profits of eternal life.^{6b-25:14-30} And *why* are the wise servants watching and working? They have learned the Master’s *way* of true life. Therefore, they have loved hungry and thirsty souls, welcomed strangers, cared for the sick, and visited prisoners with the Master’s eternal life in mind.^{7a-25:31-46} The wise servant loves like the Master—the Lamb of God—by and for His Gospel. *Servants of faith serve faithfully!*
