**A<sup>bout</sup> – Servant Service**

Mt.24:32-25:46; Mk.13:28-37; Lk.21:29-36

**B<sup>est Verse</sup>** – Mark 13:37, Jesus said, “What I say to you, I say to everyone: ‘Watch!’” The Spirit of Jesus employs and empowers certain *wise* servants who care for others, feeding them with the truth of His *word* in a timely way.<sup>24:45</sup> These servants live by the certain hope<sup>Hb11:1</sup> that they will see Jesus soon, so they are continually *watching* for His arrival as their “Bridegroom”—and they are ready when He comes.<sup>25:1-13</sup> No matter how long it takes, whatever their Master has entrusted to them, Jesus will find them *working* for Him at their stewardship when He comes.<sup>25:14-30</sup> They are busy living in the same *way* their Master lived.<sup>25:31-46</sup> In other words, they love others according to the pattern of love by which Jesus lived.<sup>Jn13:34</sup> These servants—having done *well*<sup>25:21-23</sup>—will be *welcome* to their inheritance which the Lord had in mind for them at creation.<sup>25:34</sup>

**C<sup>ommitment</sup>**— Master Bridegroom, I cannot say that I have been faithful to Your call, so I am glad that You promise faithfulness to me as Your child.<sup>2Tm2:13</sup>
